This show is for younger and novice riders, we want to create a safe and relaxed environment for them. Therefore, we do not feel it is suitable for young horses as they are inevitably often a bit flighty. We kindly ask therefore that young horses or very young ponies are not entered at the show.

All horses and ponies entered must be aged 4 and over.

Entry information

CONDITIONS AND INFORMATION □ Rosettes will be awarded to 1st – 6th placed individuals □ Entries will be accepted on the day subject to a late entry fee □ Judges' decision will be final. Any person wishing to lodge an objection must do so to the secretary within 30 minutes of the incident, with a deposit of £10.00 which will be returned if the objection is upheld. □ The organisers reserve the right to cancel any class, to divide any class and to refuse any entry without stating any reason. Anyone behaving in an inappropriate manner will be asked to leave.

Please Note: This competition is run according to Pony Club Show Jumping rules.

NUMBER BIBS – all competitors will be expected to provide their own number bib and print out their own numbers. A number template can be found in the documents pack for this event on Horse Events.

TIMES – all show jumping competitors will be issued with an allocated start time and a rider number by 6pm on Friday 17th July 2026.

Live results will be published on the day on Pony Club Results

*Important qualifying info for Bicton Mini Champs 2026 – The top Branch team, if less than 5 teams are entered, or the top two Branch teams if 5 or more teams are entered; plus the top three individuals, whether

they are in a team or not, from each of the following classes: 40cm Lead Rein, 40cm Assisted, 40cm Unassisted, 50cm and 60cm, will qualify for the Championships on 26-28 August 2026 at Bicton Arena.
